### **Agricultural Compliance Specialist**

The Lancaster County Conservation District is seeking two qualified individuals to fill full-time positions as an Agriculture Compliance Specialists. These positions require excellent organization, communication and technical skills. Attention to detail and the ability to learn quickly is a must. Self motivated applicants are appreciated. The successful applicants will be responsible for contracted and delegated duties under various District programs. Compliance Specialists will be expected to conduct onsite inspections of farming operations within the county. Those site inspections will include paperwork review, site verification and compliance documentation, relating to Pennsylvania's Agriculture Regulations (Chapter 102.4 & Chapter 91). Compliance documentation will also be used in both electronic and hardcopy forms. Knowledge of farming operations, Pennsylvania Law relating to Agriculture, and good communications skills are key. Upon employment, candidate will be required to complete a State and Federal background investigation questionnaire.

Minimum qualifications are:

- Bachelor's degree required. A degree in Agronomy, Soil Science, Plant Science, Animal Science or related environmental studies preferred
- Valid drivers license and personal vehicle
- Ability to traverse rough terrain
