The Lancaster County Conservation District has a vacancy for an Assistant Watershed Specialist position in the Watershed Program. The person in this position will have a blend of both technical and scientific obligations along with landowner and nonprofit liaison skills. Responsibilities include watershed project oversight (permit and design), education, watershed planning/assessment, water monitoring, and GIS/computer entry. The successful applicant must possess good writing and communication skills and be competent in the application of basic algebra and geometry. Applicants should have the ability to interpret topographic survey maps and engineered drawings. Experience in the construction or water monitoring industry is beneficial.
