Agriculture Engineering Technician

The Lancaster County Conservation District is seeking qualified individuals to fill a full-time Agriculture Engineering Technician position. This position requires excellent organization, communication and technical skills. Applicants who are self-motivated, detail oriented and able to learn quickly should apply. The successful applicants will be responsible for assisting the engineering staff in technical planning and design assistance to accelerate the installation of best management practices (BMPs). Skill level must include a working knowledge of CAD and GIS. Knowledge of the PA Technical Guide is preferred.

Upon employment, candidates will be required to complete a State and Federal background investigation questionnaire.

Minimum qualifications are:

- 2 years of engineering experience preferred.
- Associate's degree required. Bachelor's degree preferred. A degree in Agriculture, Environmental or Civil Engineering or Engineering Technology or related environmental studies preferred
- Valid drivers license and personal vehicle
- Ability to traverse rough terrain
