

Resource Conservationist

The mission of the Lancaster County Conservation District (LCCD) is to promote the stewardship of natural resources for Lancaster County and beyond. LCCD is looking for a Resource Conservationist to join its Erosion & Sedimentation (E&S) Team. This individual will join the E&S Team in implementing the Chapter 102 regulatory program that aims to protect the waters of Lancaster County from the harmful effects of accelerated erosion, sedimentation, and stormwater runoff.

Job Responsibilities

- Review Erosion & Sediment Control Plans and Post-Construction Stormwater Management Plans
- Process National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits associated with construction activities
- Conduct project site inspections and generate associated reports
- Investigate delegated complaints
- Effectively communicate with the public, permittees, plan designers, and cooperating agencies

Required Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in environmental science, geology, hydrology, earth science, natural resource management, conservation, engineering, construction management, or a related field preferred. Applicants possessing an equivalent combination of education & experience will be considered.
- Ability to apply basic algebra and geometry to plan and permit reviews
- Dedication to District's mission of promoting the stewardship of natural resources through erosion control, stormwater management, and environmental regulation
- High integrity in professional judgements and determinations
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Valid driver's license and personal vehicle
- Ability to traverse rough terrain

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience in the design, construction, review or inspection of erosion & sediment control or stormwater management practices
- Working knowledge of land development processes and local governments
- Expertise in generating review letters and inspection reports
- Experience interpreting site surveys, plan drawings, and maps
